Don't flush money away

Washrooms and toilets are an area where a lot of businesses use a lot of water. Are you literally flushing money down the drain?



Dropping cistern water savers in the toilet saves around 1 litre with every flush. It makes spending a penny less expensive!

An overflowing cistern sends water straight down the drain. Fit **new washers** and **ball-valves** to stop wastage and check overflows regularly.

Urinals set to flush regardless of how often they're used waste a lot of water, especially when no one is at work. Fitting devices like **passive infrared sensors, hydraulic valves** or **flush timers**, and having **efficient flush toilets** puts you in control of the flow.

Install water saving equipment

Automatic taps that switch on and off just when you use them means no one can leaving them running.

Simply fitting **tap aerators** can mean up to 50% less water coming out of your taps.

Spray taps are great if you use tap water a lot. They work by forcing water through small holes creating a mist or spray and can cut the amount used by up to 70%.

Auto shut-off hosepipes and urinal controls in washrooms are other good ways to use less, and the costs will pay for themselves in the amount of water you save in the long-term.

Get help from our government

Did you know the government has a scheme to help with costs? Water saving devices on the Water Technology List, part of the government's Enhanced Capital Allowance (ECA) Scheme, are cheaper than you think.

The ECA lets businesses claim 100% first year capital allowances on investments in technologies and products that encourage sustainable water use. Businesses can write off the whole cost of their investment against their taxable profits of the period in which they make the investment. For more information visit the [ECA website](#).

Wrap up well for winter

Ensure your business is ready for any cold spells by insulating tanks, cisterns and external pipework. A burst pipe is damaging and inconvenient. It could also cost your business a lot of money in wasted water.

Fit a water butt
