
Your bill explained

This bill shows the information you'll see if you pay for water and wastewater with us and you have a water meter.

You might get bills from us for water or wastewater only and then only see that information but the way we do the bill is the same.







Fixed charges

A fixed charge to cover the cost of services and contribute to the cost of the water

Water volume charge

Shows what your last meter reading and most recent reading is. (A) means it's an actual meter read and (E) means we've estimated the reading based on your history of readings and water usage. If you read your own meter regularly and send us the readings via our website you can control the accuracy of your bill.

Charge dates

You may see more than one set of charge dates if prices have changed because you've gone on to a new contract or the wholesale price has changed in a bill that includes April.

Water usage

We use the difference between your previous and latest readings to work out how much water you've used (volume) and what you need to pay for.

Cost of water

This is the price you pay (the rate) for the water you've used, set by the wholesaler for the year and starting in April.

Used water charge

The amount of water you've used multiplied by the cost (for 1 meter cubed of water) gives the overall cost of the water you've used over the time period of the bill.

Total water charge

The cost of the clean water you've used and the fixed charges that go with this.

Surface water and highway drainage

This is the rainwater that falls on your property, and surrounding roads and pathways that drains away in to the public sewer and is then treated and cleaned. You pay a set price based on the size of your property and charged at a daily rate.

Total charges

The total cost of the water you've used, the fixed charges, plus any amount you still owe from the last bill, or minus any amount your account is in credit.

Cost of wastewater

Based on the amount of water you've used but with a discounted price, as not all water you use goes back into the sewer because of losses like evaporation.

Total waste water charges

The cost of the wastewater that's left your premises and a fixed charge for the rainwater that's drained away.

New charges

Total cost of the water and/or wastewater you've used plus the fixed charges.
